## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Regular Laundry: Add 125ml (4oz) per load of regular wash

Work Clothes: For items such as rig underclothes, T-shirts, long johns, etc. add 187ml (6oz) to standard capacity washing machine

Coveralls: Use 375ml for 7-10 pairs of coveralls (depending on size) in your regular 55lb washer

Heavy Soils: For heavily soiled items involving grease, heavy oil, invert drilling mud, paraffins and proteins, use BioSol SUPER KIK as a presoak along with KIK for best results.
